I work with UK Black Tech and its Founder, as a business consultant to help it become a self-sustaining business, so it can focus on extending its resources to the tech community it strives to grow, rather than looking for resources; UKBT has now launched the London Innovation Hub, which I continue to support. In parallel, over the past 3 years, I've planned & delivered quarterly CV review/interview prep workshops to BAME professionals with unconventional backgrounds, that're looking to break into fintech. I've extended both knowledge and experience to prevent talented individuals from being prematurely denied or not considered for their dream careers. 6 have happily reported to have gotten their first job in fintech—some at xxxxx, others at startups. I've offered pro-bono consulting to BAME startup founders, often leading workshops ("Generating Traction for your Startup" +more). Those founders have gone on to gain new clients.

10. What has been your personal impact upon FinTech? (max 150 words)

My philosophy has always been – if I truly want to make a big impact in the fintech space, I need to scale my efforts; I've intentionally taught others that normally wouldn't have the resources or connections, to fish. And have enlisted them to help run subsequent workshops to impart fintech knowledge + extend opportunities. It's bigger than me or a company. Knowing I've actually managed to build bridges to fintech opportunities for others has been the sources of my happiness. I didn't "set it and forget it" – there was follow-through after workshops, I had focus group calls, coaching sessions for their interviews. I wanted to make sure they knew someone believed in them enough to be available to support them to the closing (recruitment decision). I'm elated to see them tweet about their work or post LinkedIn articles about the industry. It adds to the feeling of purpose.
